6:30 A.M.

On October 7, 2023, the terrorist group Hamas launched a horrifying terror attack against Israel of unparalleled scope in the annals of our country. Accompanied by thousands of rockets fired in just one morning, some 3,000 Gazan terrorists overran Israel's southern border, hellbent on taking and destroying as many Israeli lives as they could; to traumatize and instill fear in our nation. Why? Because we're Jews.

Men, women, children, elderly—even infants—were shot, stabbed, burned, maimed, and raped to death in the most murderous, barbaric terror event since the Holocaust. Leaving over 10,000 people injured, Hamas reduced homes, cars, businesses, and entire communities to rubble. Almost 250 of our loved ones were taken hostage into Hamas' tunnels of darkness in Gaza, and the State of Israel immediately responded with a declaration of war, with Swords of Iron. Israel now finds itself in a war for its existence, to secure its borders, destroy the terrorist organization Hamas, and bring our hostages home.

On October 7, Hamas seized control over several communities and military targets in southern Israel. As the IDF, the police, and Israeli security forces fought to retake the South, the survivors of the attacks needed prompt, direct aid. Amid the turmoil, Keren Hayesod-UIA instantly sprung into action and launched our Brothers' Keeper emergency campaign. Fueled by your swift response and heartwarming outpouring of support, we were able to immediately funnel aid where most needed: KH-supported projects, municipalities, hospitals, rescue services, and more. Thanks to your help, Israeli hospitals managed to accommodate the sudden, massive influx of hundreds of wounded survivors following the attacks.





TOGETHER, WE ARE BRINGING OUR PEOPLE HOME.

Amid the turmoil of national trauma, we've seen over 2,400 new Olim make Israel their home just since October 7, and Keren Hayesod-UIA is as determined as ever to welcome them home and facilitate their integration to give them a fresh, prosperous start in Israel.

Absorption centers meet Olim's essential needs, easing their transition with Hebrew classes and preparatory academic and vocational programs to consolidate the newcomers' toolkit to help them integrate economically and culturally. Such programs include the Profession for Life retraining program and the Professional Licensing and Training Program.



Youth in Israel's periphery are far removed from the economic and educational opportunities available in the country's center. Keren Hayesod-UIA supports diverse programs that trigger long-lasting change for Israeli adolescents.

- Closing Social Gaps: The devoted mentors of the Youth Futures program use positive social and
 educational enrichment to disadvantaged children, mainly from the periphery, to cultivate their talents and
 help them bridge significant educational and social gaps.
- Guidance for Adolescents: Four educational Youth Villages around Israel offer remedial education and
 emotional support in a warm atmosphere for disadvantaged teens. This rich extra-curricular program
 enhances potential school dropouts' sense of social responsibility and ensures they finish school and get
 tools for a productive future.
- Bridging the Digital Divide: The Net@ program is among Israel's most effective after-school tech programs
 for upward social mobility. Over 2,000 pupils in grades 5-12 hone their computer network design, math,
 and English skills, drastically improving their competitiveness in the job market. Net@ graduates become
 Cisco Systems-certified network technicians and gather valuable practical experience through community
 volunteering.

The staff of dedicated professionals offers residents a wide gamut of enrichment activities—lectures, Hebrew lessons, classes, exercise groups, trips, and much more!

Masa Israel Programs

Programs designed to build a lifetime of love for Israel and the Jewish people.



In 2023, we were fortunate to host 11,571 young adults between 18-30 years old from 61 different countries through **Masa Israel**, a household name for Jews worldwide and in Israel alike. **Masa Israel programs** help young Diaspora Jews fortify their connection with their homeland, and Keren Hayesod-UIA is proud to participate in building a whole new generation of youngsters whose bond to Israel will remain an unshakable part of their identity.

Through 243 programs, **Masa Israel** brings young adults to Israel for one semester or year-long educational and internship programs designed to create a lifetime of love for Israel and reinforce the ties to their Jewish heritage. Secular and religious programs, along with internship and volunteer arrangements, are tailored to the interests of the participants and in cooperation with universities, yeshivot, youth movements, and state institutions. Participants study Hebrew, meet with Israelis, and tour the country, growing personally and professionally as they deepen their knowledge about Judaism, the Land of Israel, and its bustling society.

Mechinot are, post-high school academies geared to underprivileged youth, new Olim, Haredim, Druze, and others, offering powerful programming for upward social mobility that incorporates leadership training and volunteering programs. The year-long Mechina programs are designed to help participants to strengthen their personal identity and navigate their way into the next phases of their life. Our programs help these young immigrants take the next step in making Israel their forever home.




The Jewish Agency's **Fund for Victims of Terror** received US\$24.5 million in direct support dedicated to the short-term needs of the survivors of the October 7 massacres. Within a few days of the attacks, the Fund had distributed more grants than in its 21 years of existence—combined—and has provided over 7,800 grants to date.

Municipalities received a vital injection of US\$7.3 million; hospitals and rescue services were fortified with US\$8.5 million. Thanks to your invaluable help, an impressive 337,845 meals were supplied to evacuees, exemplifying the power of our collective compassion!
