




**IMPACT** REPORT 2022



## SAVING UKRAINIAN JEWS' LIVES IN THE SHADOW OF WAR

More than \$22.8M was raised to support Ukrainian Jewish refugees. When faced with a new sense of distance and crisis, our support was more important than ever.

Since Russia's wide-ranging attack on Ukraine, which started on February 24, 2022, Keren Hayesod and our strategic partner, The Jewish Agency for Israel, worked around the clock to provide critical assistance during this humanitarian crisis.

Thanks to all of you, our supporters from around the world, we were able to raise funds in support of crucial operations, such as rescue operations that brought Jewish refugees from Ukraine to Israel, as well as delivering essential goods to refugees in countries bordering Ukraine, such as medicine and other critical supplies.

Our World Chairman, Sam Grundwerg, and Chairman of the World Board of Trustees, Steven Lowy AM, traveled to the border of Ukraine with members of our leadership, and together with the Jewish Agency for Israel and the Government of Israel to learn firsthand where Keren Hayesod's assistance is needed.

Despite the chaos and uncertainty, Keren Hayesod and the Jewish Agency remained at the forefront of the emergency efforts to bring Ukrainian Jewish refugees to safety.

#### **ALIYAH & ABSORPTION**

In 2022, we welcomed home 74,915 new Olim from 93 countries.

From their early dreams of making their homeland home to landing in Israel, and after, we are there for them.

Keren Hayesod has been committed for more than 102 years to helping the Jewish people make Israel their home.

Following a few challenging years due to the pandemic, we assisted Jews from every corner of the world that wanted to make Aliyah, including Jewish refugees from Ukraine who were forced to flee their homes seeking shelter and safety.

After officially becoming Israeli, our Olim are grateful for the unique programs we support to help them as they make Israel their new home. Thanks to our generous donors, **4,586 new Olim enrolled in Ulpan programs in 2022.** 

Ulpan programs have been proven transformative for new Olim . These programs provide varied support, including a first home, an immediate community of other new immigrants, Hebrew language classes, trips exploring Israel, programs to learn more about Jewish identity, and more. Staff at these programs also help the new Olim find their next steps in Israel – housing, employment, further education, and whatever else they need to succeed in their new country.

Select Ulpans also host the A Profession for Life program. In 2022, 229 immigrants benefited from the program, which helps participants convert professional licenses and gain new qualifications relevant to the Israeli job market. The program's 11 tracks include medicine, engineering, and other technical specialties. Participants benefit from Hebrew classes – general language classes and specialty classes related to their chosen profession, and occupational training. Their families also benefit from housing in absorption centers and extended support to ease the transition to life in Israel.


In 2022, we served as key partners in the second phase of **Operation Tzur Israel**. This special initiative was **part of our ongoing efforts to assist the thousands of Ethiopian Jews that have been waiting decades to make Aliyah and reunite with their families and relatives already living in Israel.** Together with the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration and The Jewish Agency for Israel, we will continue supporting projects focused on Aliyah from Ethiopia.

## SUPPORTING ISRAEL'S NEXT GENERATION

Thousands of at-risk children and teenagers benefit from interventions we support.

We prioritize the importance of ensuring that Israel's next generation receives the **education**, **assistance**, and **interventions necessary** to help them succeed. Together, **we make sure that Israel's children**, **teenagers**, and their **families** have the **resources to flourish** at every stage of their development.

For younger children, our Youth Futures project empowers over 12,000 atrisk children (ages 6-13 years old) and their families in 36 locations and 190 schools annually. The program provides personalized attention, positive social experiences, and educational enrichment that help Israeli children develop their strengths and bridge scholastic, social, and cultural gaps.

At the core of the program are 250 mentors across the country. Each participant benefits from being paired with a mentor, and mentors typically have no more than 16 mentees a year. Mentors work directly with each child and their families, schools, and communities to provide more holistic and personalized interventions. Graduates of the program speak highly of the life-changing impact of having a mentor who worked directly with them to build their skills and establish stronger foundations to succeed as they moved forward in life.

We also work with Israel's at-risk teenagers through the **four Youth Villages** we support. In 2022, these advanced educational centers helped **800 students** in **secondary education** to **break the cycle of poverty, overcome educational** and **socioeconomic gaps** and become **contributing members of Israeli society**.



Our Youth Villages provide students with everything they need – specially trained and dedicated staff, dormitories with a home-like atmosphere, small classrooms, a range of therapy options, skill-building activities, and select tracks focused on providing in-demand tools for success in the army, university and the Israeli job market.

Our education portfolio includes Net@, one of the most effective agents of social mobility in Israel. Since 2003, Net@ has led the movement to equip underserved Israeli youth with a technological education and leadership skills. This past year, 2,000 students in grades 5-12 facing socioeconomic challenges or living in the geographic periphery were coached by dedicated Net@ mentors. Net@ students earn advanced certificates in a range of computer skills – coding, technician training, graphic design, digital marketing, and more.

With more than **20 locations**, Net@ focuses on **entrepreneurship** and **youth training youth**. FixIt, community computer labs managed by participants, extend the opportunity for students to gain confidence, skills, and leadership training.

Net@ is a joint initiative of Keren Hayesod, The Jewish Agency for Israel, Cisco, and Appleseeds Academy and is the only long-term youth program in Israel to bring together Jewish, Muslim, and Christian youth.

#### THE ELDERLY

### Together, we are helping care for the generation who cared for us.

Keren Hayesod supporters worldwide will recognize the name Amigour, Israel's leading sheltered housing company and a leader in the country's public housing sector.

Together with Amigour and the Jewish Agency for Israel, Keren Hayesod is helping to address Israel's housing crisis and its impact on our elderly. More than 21 percent of Israelis over the age of 65 years old are living close to or below the poverty line. Many are Holocaust survivors, immigrants from the FSU, and others that lack both means and a strong support network. They struggle to provide for themselves, purchase food, and even afford housing.

Amigour responds to this urgent need for housing. The project offers **7,000 elderly** Israelis affordable homes and, most importantly, more secure and independent living. Residents enjoy high-quality units in prime locations throughout Israel. They also benefit from trained support staff, diverse programming to fill their days, and a strong sense of community.

Keren Hayesod is working with our partners to expand these offerings. With thousands more on the waitlist, we are helping to build 2,650 additional units.

The State of Israel has announced that in light of the success of the Social Housing initiative and in light of the increasing demand and waiting lists for housing for the elderly, the government wants to expand the Amigour project by adding 1,500 more residential units.

#### **Exploring global peoplehood in Israel**

Masa Israel Journey provides young Jews worldwide with an unparalleled opportunity to experience Israel. Young Jews, aged 18-30 years old, from around the globe benefit from Masa's global leadership, study, volunteer, and career development programs in Israel. Each year, thousands of Jews arrive in Israel for an in-depth and authentic experience. These 4-12 month programs provide personal and professional growth as participants immerse themselves in Israeli society, connect to their roots and culture, explore Jewish identity, and deepen their relationship with Israel and the Jewish people.

Masa also gives young adults considering Aliyah the chance to spend time in Israel before making the move official. **Annually, 30% of Masa fellows decide to make Israel their forever home.**

## PREPARING OUR YOUNG FOR THEIR NEXT CHAPTER IN LIFE

Following the completion of high school, many youths lack the skills and tools to unlock their full potential during the next period in their lives. We help disadvantaged youth and new Olim to overcome obstacles, make the most of their post-high school, and young adult years and help them be prepared for the next steps in their life.

Mechinot, post-high school academies, provide crucial training and interventions for at-risk youth and new immigrants. In 2022, we supported **17 Mechinot** that **empowered 670 youths from Israel and abroad**. Participation in our Mechinot helps participants to strengthen their personal identity and navigate their way into the next phases of their life. **Our programs help these young immigrants take the next step in making Israel their forever home.** 







We are confident that 2023 will be another year as part of our storied history in which we continue to have a profound impact on Israeli society.


As time has demonstrated, even when a crisis arises or we face mutual challenges, if we stand united, we have the power to change lives and bring the Jewish people together.
